

## Key Messages from the Town Hall Meeting – January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025

#### If you believe your home was not Substantially Damaged: Please take Action!

- 1. You can request a reassessment: File online at <u>pinellas.gov/sdsi</u> within 60 days from receiving your letter. You will need to also create an account through Pinellas County Access Portal and add supporting documents. (*steps are detailed on page 4 on the Pinellas County Substantial Damage Reassessment Instructions*)
- 2. Ask Pinellas County to provide you with a copy of your detailed assessment that they did to consider why you are substantially damaged? Ask to see the "proof"? Call in
- 3. Go to website <u>pinellas.gov/sdsi</u> if you need to view your substantial damage letter, although all letters were mailed to your address.
- 4. Hire an independent Florida licensed residential appraiser to conduct an independent appraisal <u>OR</u> you can contact the County for a type of appraisal termed as: Pre-storm building value reconsideration (BVR) <u>https://www/pcpao.gov/how-do-i/request-bvr</u> ( letters were mailed from Mike Twitty) # 727-464-3207
- 5. *Side Note*: If you had a copy of the Door Tag on your home: if Green or Black posted by the Pinellas County in October 2024- take a photo and enclose with your application (#1)
- 6. Go to the Pinellas County Property Appraiser website (WLM/FEMA letter) if you have not already accessed your address from site: pcpao.gov
- 7. Time Extension: It indicates on the substantial damage letter page 2 paragraph 4 *you may request an extension* if it looks like your plan to bring your home up to the current building and floodplain management regulated will not be completed by June 1, 2025.

#### If you need help filling out county paperwork Online:

- Contact the Pinellas County in person or call.
- Go to 440 Court Street 4<sup>th</sup> floor Clearwater they will assist with ALL your paperwork.
- The HOA will see if we can hire someone on site to assist If anyone is aware of someone with this skill set, please let us know.
- In the meantime Please do not wait.
